The Systems of government which men have evolved during the past 2500 years have been the subject of study of social and political scientists. In recent times, an essential prerequisite of political modernization by states has been the adoption of a national constitution. Ours is a thoroughly written constitution. The preamble of it speaks of "we the people of India" making a solemn resolve to constitute India into a "Sovereign, Socialist, Secular and democratic Republic" Securing for all its citizens Justice liberty and equality, and promoting among them all fraternity, Justice is further defined as social economic and political. Liberty includes liberty of thought, expression, belief, faith and worship, and equality means equality of status and of opportunity. The fundamental document for the study of nature and functioning of democracy in India is its Constitution.

However, many important features of our polity are a continuation of the British political practice. These include among other, the liberal democratic nature of the Indian Constitution, Parliamentary form of government, the Indian Civil Service and the Unitary character of the Indian state, where the Emergency and residual powers lie with Central Government.

The purpose of our study is to evaluate the working of democracy in India. The success of democracy in Indian is beyond expectation of theorists and thinkers of the time. As illiteracy, the inequality and extreme poverty were the bane for the newly born independent India. John Stuart Mill went far to say that the huge illiterate population was a hindrance to the implementation of Adult suffrage. But Radha Krishnan dismissed Mill's claim and declared that all Indians irrespective of gender and education were always suited to self rule. Kakolat water fall, a great tourist spot, is 40KM away from here, Sitamarhi where sita, wife of Lord Rama lived in Exile with Lava and kusha, is 20KM. away from here.
